Investment Objective

The First Trust AlphaDEX™ U.S. Industrials Sector Index ETF seeks to replicate, to the extent possible, the performance of the StrataQuant® Industrials Index (the "Index"), net of expenses. The investment strategy of the First Trust ETF is to invest in and hold the constituent securities of the Index in the same proportion as they are reflected in the Index or securities intended to replicate the performance of the Index. The Index employs the AlphaDEX™ methodology to select stocks from the Russell 1000® Index that are within the industrials/producer durables sector. The Russell 1000® Index is a market index representing the large- and mid-capitalization segment of the U. S. equity universe.

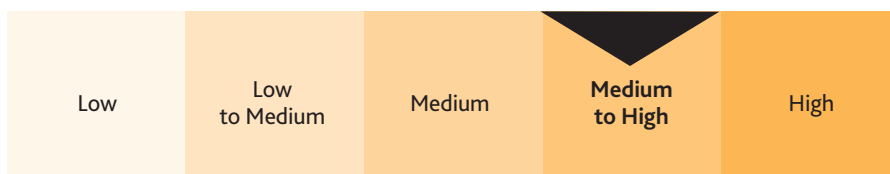

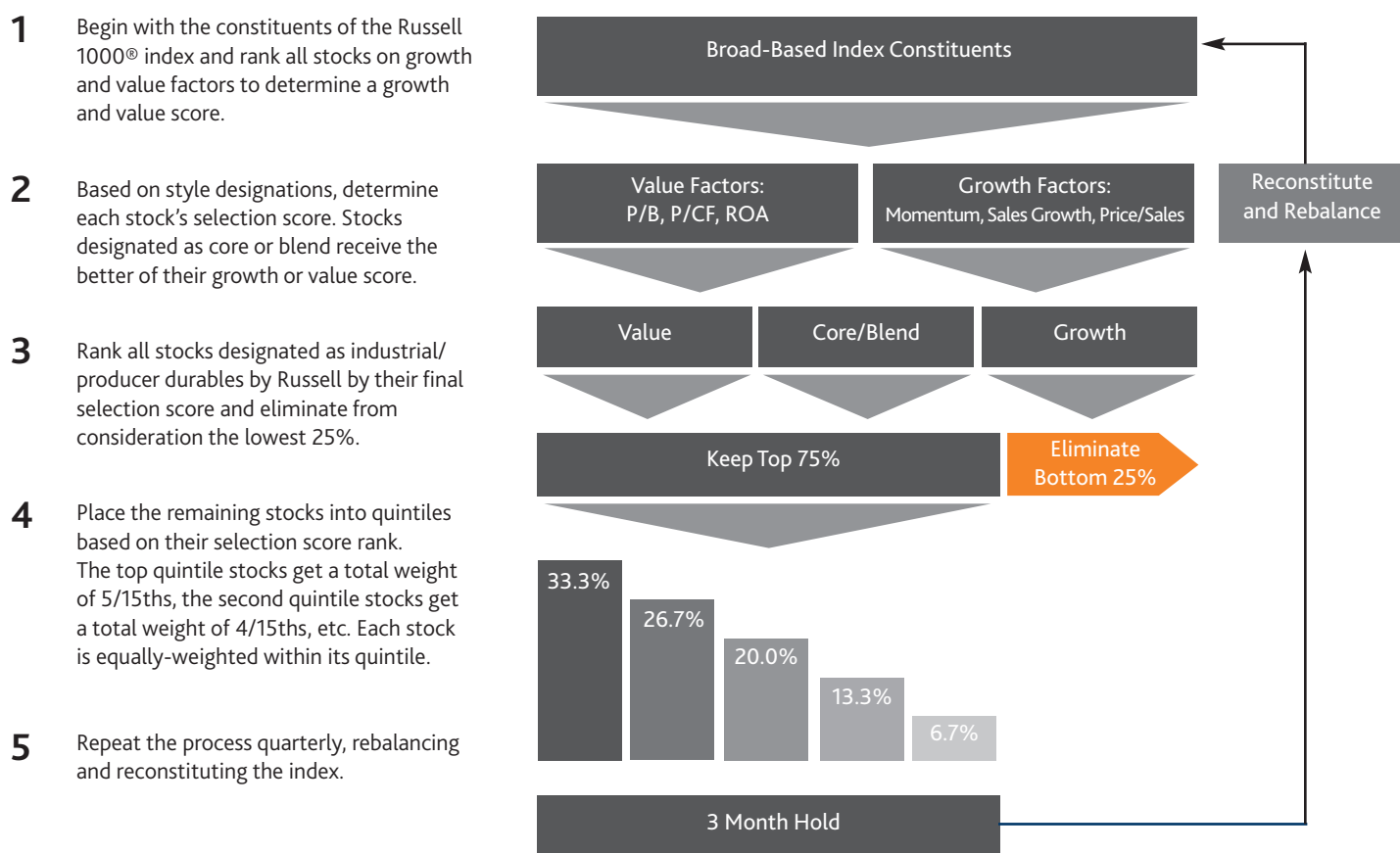

AlphaDEX™ U.S. Industrials Sector Index Methodology

The indexes which provide the basis for the AlphaDEX™ exchange-traded funds start with a broad-based index and are enhanced through the use of the proprietary AlphaDEX™ stock selection methodology. This methodology is designed to use value and growth factors to select and weight stocks based on their investment merit. The methodology used to select the stocks for the indexes is described in the chart below.
